



1st CONVOCATION

Saturday, June 3, 2023



Salim Habib University, Karachi, held its first Convocation on Saturday, June 3, 2023, in its MBB Auditorium. In the grand ceremony, degrees were conferred upon the University's graduates of the years 2021 and 2022 for the programs Doctor of Pharmacy, BE Biomedical Engineering, BS Computer Science, BS Biosciences, BS Accounting & Finance, BBA and MBA.

Successful graduates expressed their joy at being a part of the historic first Convocation of Salim Habib University, of witnessing their hard work paying off, and of now being a member of the alumni network of their university that has, through its unmatched educational facilities, ensured that their future will be bright.

ACADEMIC PROCESSION

It is a convention of Convocation ceremonies of higher education institutions that the Faculty members, as well as the policymakers, of the institution enter the Convocation hall in a formation known as the academic procession.

THE CEREMONY

The Convocation ceremony, conducted by Prof. Dr. Kaleem Raza Khan, Registrar, commenced officially when Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Shakeel Ahmed Khan requested the Honorable Chancellor Dr. Iram Afaq to declare the Convocation open, and she did so.



Following this, the program proceeded with beautiful recitation from the Holy Quran by Hafiz Haris Ijaz Yazdani, a graduate of the Biomedical Engineering program at Salim Habib University, and a heart-touching rendition of a Naat by Mr. Muhammad Atiq, Assistant Manager Systems, Department of Information and Communication Technology, Salim Habib University.



Degrees were then conferred upon graduates via the traditional process, through which Registrar Prof. Dr. Kaleem Raza Khan asked the Dean of each Faculty to present to the Vice Chancellor those candidates who have passed the examinations of their particular degree program and have been found qualified for the Degree, and the Deans, in turn, presented said successful candidates to the Vice Chancellor. Prof. Dr. Shakeel Ahmed Khan, then, by the virtue of the authority vested in him as the Vice Chancellor of the University, declared that he admits each student to their particular degree and charged them to ever in their lives and conversation prove themselves worthy of the same.



It is no exaggeration that the momentous ceremony had the audience enthralled throughout the conferment of degrees and awarding of medals till the moment Chancellor Dr. Iram Afaq declared the Convocation closed.


The host for the ceremony, before the Convocation was declared open and after it was declared closed, was Ms. Sibgha Raza Khan.

AWARDING OF DEGREES AND MEDALS

At the Convocation, degrees were awarded to 113 students, while 14 high achievers received gold medals, and 12 were awarded silver medals.

BEST UNIVERSITY TEACHER AWARD




